Reduction of Delivery Quarantine Time to 5 Days

IHLS Members,

We are pleased to announce that in anticipation of guidance for libraries from the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, Illinois Heartland Library System is reducing the quarantine time for interlibrary delivery materials and tubs from 7 days to 5 days, starting immediately. We will continue to quarantine these items on libraries' behalves within our hubs. Should IDPH and DCEO recommend a shorter or longer quarantine time, then we will adjust our quarantine period accordingly.

Please continue to add a date to the outside of your tubs in the plastic label pocket. This date should indicate the last time that items inside the tub were touched by human hands.

IHLS Delivery leadership and the IHLS Delivery Working Group regularly review the available science regarding library materials, library environments, and what is known about the transmission and infectiousness of the coronavirus. After reviewing and considering the newest research and literature reviews to the best of our ability as non-virologists, we came to the conclusion that it is safe to make this change to 5 days prior to receiving a response from the Illinois Department of Public Health.

Meanwhile, IHLS staff continue to practice the following safety procedures:

- disinfecting commonly touched workspaces and tubs, paying special attention to high-touch areas such as handles,
- · requiring handwashing every 30 minutes,
- requiring masks for IHLS staff when around library materials or other people
- using temperature scanners to monitor the temperatures of all staff members before they enter an IHLS building and sending staff members home if they have a temperature reading above the state guideline of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit,
- following the Emergency Travel Order issued by the Chicago Department of Public Health,
- following guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Illinois Department of Public Health, and
- regularly reevaluating our policies and procedures for improvement.


Account Creation for New Staff

Library staff without an L2 account can <u>create one here</u>. If you have an account but have forgotten the password, you can <u>reset</u> it here.

As part of the account security structure, library directors are no longer able to create new L2 accounts for others, but they can add people who have L2 accounts to their library staff lists. To do that, library directors or others on staff with admin permissions can do the following once an account has been created and confirmed by the user:

- In the <u>L2 Directory</u>, navigate to the library location where the staff member works. At the top of the page, click on the "Affiliations" button to bring up the list of affiliations for that location. This page should also have a section labeled "Add an Affiliation."
- In the "Add an Affiliation" section, under "User," type in the staff member's name to bring up a list of matches.
 This could be their first name, last name, or email address. Once the proper result is shown, click on it to enter it into the textbox.
- In the "Primary Affiliation" section, you will need to select "Primary Affiliation" if this is the staff member's primary affiliation. If this is not their primary affiliation (e.g., it's their second job), select "Other Affiliation."
- Select and/or enter the appropriate information in "Role/Access Group," "Job Title," and contact information fields.
- Click on the "Save" button at the bottom of the page to save the location affiliation.
